

Exemplary tailor made Poland tour

The tour includes a longer stay in Toruń, a charming, medieval town where the famous astronomer Nicolai Copernicus was born. After an intense day in busy Warsaw, the capital city and Poland's most cosmopolitan, dynamic and progressive urban centre, Toruń is a nice, relaxing change, not to mention the amazingly low prices for quality hotels in the Old Town. Following the traces of Teutonic Knights we drove to the world-famous castle in Malbork to have a closer look at the largest gothic brick construction in Europe. We ended the bus tour in Solidarity town of Gdańsk, with more sightseeing and group activities.

Day one

Arrival in **Warsaw**; meeting the tour leader at the airport; transfer to the hotel by taxi or a chartered bus (depending on the number of participants). Check in; afternoon / evening for individual exploration (the hotel is located in the centre).

Day two

- 8.00 – 9.00** breakfast in the hotel; check out from the hotel with luggage;
- 9.15 – 14.00** bus & walking sightseeing tour of Warsaw with a local guide.
- 14.00** lunch in a restaurant located in the Old Town.
- 15.00 – 18.00** free time for shopping or more sightseeing – the local guide recommends places worth a visit, such as the Palace of Culture and Science or the Royal Castle (free admission on Sundays).
- 18.00 – 21.00** driving to the hotel in Toruń; check in.

Day three

- 9.00** breakfast in the hotel restaurant.
- 10.30 – 14.00** sightseeing with the local English speaking guide – **a walking tour of Toruń.**
- 14.00 – 18.00** free time for lunch & individual exploration, with recommended restaurants, museums and activities (a boat ride etc.)
- 19.00** dinner for the whole group in a selected restaurant.

Day four

- 8.00 – 9.00** breakfast in the hotel restaurant.
- 9.15** check out; drive to the “brick beast” – **the Malbork castle.**
- 11.45 – 13.45** sightseeing of the castle with a local guide .
- 14.00** lunch in the castle's restaurant.
- 15.30 – 17.30** drive to the hotel in Gdańsk; check in; in the evening the tour leader can accompany the guests who wish to experience the vibrant nightlife in Tri-City Metropolis, especially the fashionable seaside resort Sopot, Poland's summer capital city.

Day five

- 9.00 – 10.00** breakfast in the hotel restaurant.
- 10.00** **sightseeing of the Tri-City Metropolis**, including Oliwa Cathedral, Sopot and Gdynia, Old Town of Gdańsk (Saint Mary's Church).
- 15.00** lunch in a restaurant in the Old Town of Gdańsk.
- 16.00** a visit to a multimedia exhibition **Roads to Freedom** (with a short walk to the Shipyard and the Monument of the Fallen Shipyard Workers) – this arrangement can also be moved to the next day.
- 17.00** free time for shopping and individual exploration.
- 19.30** a farewell group dinner in a selected restaurant.

Day six – departure, transfer to the airport in Gdańsk or the ferry terminal in Gdynia.

- 9.00 – 10.00** breakfast in the hotel restaurant.
- 10.30** check out with the luggage. The bus is waiting outside the hotel.
